## CAMP EQUIPMENT LIST for BOYS & GIRLS

### Junior Session



Please bring everything we recommend, but there should be no need to bring anything more! **Be sure to mark every piece of clothing and gear with your child's full name. This is so helpful for "Lost and Found."**

Children will be provided with uniforms for use while they are at Camp—middies and bloomers for girls, polo and shorts for boys.

- 2 - Long Sleeved Sweaters (wool or sweatshirts)
- 3 - Pairs of Jeans
- 8 - Pairs of Socks (at least one pair of warm wool socks)
- 8 - Sets of Underwear
- 2 - T-shirts
- 1 - Warm Bathrobe
- 2 - Sets of Sleepwear
- 1 - Pair of Water Shoes (these can be old sneakers that can get fully immersed or sport sandals with a heel strap)
- 1 - Pair of Tennis or Sport Shoes
- 1 - Pair of Sandals (we recommend sport sandals with a heel strap because of our rocky terrain and the subsequent foot injuries that flip flops can cause. If you choose to send your child with flip flops, you assume some extra risk)
- 1 - Pair of Riding Boots (for safety we require boots with a well-defined heel)
- 1 - Warm Jacket or Parka
- 1 - Pair Swimming Trunks or Swimming Suit
- 1 - Special Day Outfit  
(bright shirt, pants, or shorts, and a bandana for adventures like treasure hunts)
- 1 - Outdoor Sleeping Bag (2 sleeping bags, if your child tends to wet the bed)
- 1 - Poncho or Set of Rain Gear (it can be very wet so this is important)
- 1 - Flashlight with Battery
- 1 - Small Pillow with 2 Cases
- 2 - Bath Towels
- 2 - Washcloths
- 1 - Laundry Bag (with your child's name is on it)
  - Toilet articles
  - Tissues
  - Extra name tags
  - Stationery
  - Postage Stamps
  - Bandana

**DO NOT BRING** cell phones, iPods, electrical or battery-run equipment. And please, no money aside from what you send, in advance, for the Camp Store account. Also, do not bring valuable jewelry.

#### **Optional:**

- Small Back Pack
- Sunglasses
- Camera and Film (with your child's name on it)
- Musical Instruments
- Crazy Creek chair – *Google it* if you don't know it. They're handy.
